<b>Subject:</b>	Can save as XML-with-identical-tree		
<b>Description:</b>	<p>Any schema and any well-formed SFM file (whether valid or not) can be used to Save As XML. The resulting XML would have the exact same tree structure as the SFM file, according to the schema, and (unlike SFM) it would be indented to reflect its structure.
